H.S.A members

- General Responsibilities:
 - Must have VIRTUS training and fingerprint clearance. This includes keeping up with the monthly VIRTUS bulletins.
 - Must sell \$100 worth of Gala Ads or secure an auction donation of \$150 value.
 - Attend H.S.A meetings regularly
 - Must volunteer a minimum of 20 hours for the school of which 2 hours must be at the Parish Festival, 6 hours of Faith Formation, and the rest through school and HSA volunteering opportunities.

Delegates:

- o Serve as the contact points for parents of their grade.
- o Organize their grade bake sale donations and volunteers.
- o Plan and coordinate grade booth for Parish Festival. Secure volunteers for the booth.
- o Coordinate and execute grade trunk for Trunk or Treat
- o Organize class parties (Christmas and End of the year).
- o Positively promote the school.

- o Relay H.S.A messages to the parents via WhatsApp.
- Grade delegates are a TEAM! All class ideas must be agreed upon by all delegates. Once you have an idea you must get it approved by the HSA board.
- o Anything done for one class must be done EXACTLY the same for the other class.
- Please do not plan grade specific events on the same day as an H.S.A events.
- The term of office for delegates in one year. May be extended if needed.

Event Chairperson and Co-chairperson:

- o Each event/committee will be assigned a Vice President to facilitate communication between the committee and the board.
- Select date and event details.
- Obtain approval by the Executive Board for event details, flyers, and finances. All flyers must be sent to H.S.A president for approval by administration prior to sending out.
- o Plan their events from start to finish.
- o Responsible for promoting their event. Be sure to communicate to the board the reminders that you want sent out to parents or posted on social media.
- Arrange volunteers for their event including set up and breakdown.
- o Print flyers for school and post at all the gates
- Make copies to send in home folders (these can be made at the school, please arrange with your assigned VP for access)
- Fill out a Profit and Loss form provided by H.S.A board with all incoming and outgoing monies for event. Must be turned into to Treasurer within 7 days after the event.
- Submit a list of active committee members to the H.S.A board after the event.
- o Approve hours for committee volunteer list on Track It Forward.

Committee members:

- o Assist the chair and co-chair in the event planning.
- o Attend meetings for their assigned committee.
- Volunteer at assigned committee's event
- o A google form will be sent out for committee member sign up. The form has already been sent if interested please fill out.
- Submit volunteer hours on Track it Forward for approval

 - All families must complete a minimum of 20 volunteer hours per school year
 - 6 mandatory hours of Faith Formation
 - A minimum of 2 mandatory hours at Parish Festival
 - Remaining hours at HSA events, in school volunteer opportunities, etc.
 - Families that do not complete their 20 mandatory volunteer hours are at risk of not being invited to re-register for the following school year.
